: IMPORTANT INFORMATIONS :

1. Important Dates:

- Reporting (Arrival of participants) : 26th December, 2016 (12:00 noon).
- Opening Ceremony : 26th December, 2016 (5:00pm)
- Coach / Manager's Meeting : 26th December, 2016 (Time: 8:30 pm).
- Closing Ceremony : 30th December, 2016 by 11:00 am onwards.

2. Meal Timings :

- Breakfast : 6.00 am to 9.30 am
- Lunch : 12.30 noon to 2.00 pm
- Evening Tea : 4.00 pm to 5.00 pm
- Dinner : 7.30 pm to 9.30 pm

3. Guidelines :

- 1) The athletes winning first & second position at Cluster level shall qualify to take part in National Level Athletic Meet. However, in relays, only the first position winning team from each cluster will be allowed to participate in Nationals.
- 2) The entry forms, Travel plan, students participation details & attested identity card format which should be filled in capital letters and sent immediately on or before 15th December, 2016 at cbse.gps@gmail.com

- 3) Reporting of all participants should be done at the counter put at the organizing school on 26th December, 2016, before 12.00 noon without fail. Participants' reporting after 26th December will not be accepted.
- 4) At the time of reporting kindly show the photocopy of demand draft or other proof of the CBSE yearly sports registration fee submission of Rs. 10,000/-
- 5) GPS, Vadodara will provide accommodation to the out station participants in the school campus. The managers & coaches of outside schools are required to stay with participants.
- 6) Pick up and Drop facility shall be provided to all outside participants from Railway Station/ Bus Stand/ Airport on request to the venue.
- 7) Those who want the pick-up from Vadodara Railway Station, need to assemble at the backside of the station. (Platform no.7, Alkapuri side).
- 8) Pick up & drop facility will not be provided to those who prefer to stay in Hotel.
- 9) The participants shall be required to pay boarding and lodging charges @ Rs.1600/- (non refundable) per head at the time of reporting.
- 10) For additional days stay, extra amount will be charged against meals, as per CBSE norms.
- 11) Also, the schools are required to deposit an amount of Rs. 2000/- as caution money which shall be refunded at the time of dispersal of the participants, if no loss or damage happens to the organizing schools properties.
- 12) Misuse of school property scribbling on walls, furniture, bulletin boards, toilets walls (Loo) etc. will be severely dealt with. Breakages of any kind are subject to a fine or payment for replacement/repairs.
- 13) Consumption of liquor, drugs, tobacco and smoking is strictly prohibited during the meet and stay in the school. Anyone who violates this rule will be immediately expelled from the school campus and the matter will be reported to CBSE.
- 14) If the participants indulge themselves into any kind of damage to the school property they need to pay for it before they leave for the station.
- 15) Participants are advised not to invite any unauthorised person(s) (including relatives/ friends) from outside as they shall not get permission to visit or stay in the campus.
- 16) Participants are not allowed to wear any costly ornaments or bring any valuable

- 17) It is the responsibility of the manager/coach to bring the sick/injured participants
- 18) Switch off the light & turn off water taps when not in use.
- 19) The participants shall be provided with bedding (mattresses, bed sheets and pillows). However, participants must carry their own blankets.
- 20) All participating schools are expected to carry their own lock, key and mosquito repellents.
- 21) The participants shall be responsible for their belongings. Participants are advised not to carry expensive gadgets as the host school shall not be held responsible for any loss.
- 22) The managers/coach are required to settle the account and obtain NOC from the designated authority before their departure.

4. Compulsory :

- 1) It is compulsory for all the participants to attend the opening ceremony and closing ceremony of the function.
- 2) Each school will send one male staff member as manager for boys and a female member as manager with the girls.
- 3) Each school must issue the identity card/details to every player of its school, separately for each of the discipline in which student intends to participate as per the format of CBSE.
- 4) Participants are required to wear I-card provided by GPS during their stay in the campus.
- 5) Photos of Athletes are required along with the Manager, Coach and Principal (separate photo for individual discipline).
- 6) No player shall be permitted to participate in the CBSE Nationals without their original identity card having counter signature of the Principal of the respective cluster/zonal level competition of organizing school.
- 7) The student / player studying in class IX and above to provide CBSE registration number.
- 8) The meet shall be conducted as per the rules framed / followed by CBSE Sports 2016-17. A copy of same can be downloaded from CBSE website www.cbse.nic.in.
- 9) Age Criterion: As specified by the rules and regulations of the CBSE sports committee.

- 10) Any participant not fulfilling the above requirement before the commencement of the meet shall not be permitted to participate.
- 11) Managers / coaches have to report at the reporting Counter for Registration as soon as they reach the venue.
- 12) Managers have to collect the event schedule, Room Nos. from the Registration Counter immediately after their arrival.
- 13) All managers and coaches meeting will be on 26th December 2016 at 8:30pm.
- 14) The participant must report for their event in the call room, before 1 hour of the event.
- 15) The decision of referees shall remain final and binding upon all concerned.
- 16) No participant shall be entertained if all desired documents are not submitted at the time of reporting.

5. General Discipline :

- 1) It is expected from each participant to be in absolute discipline during the meet and stay in GPS, Vadodara campus. If any kind of indiscipline is noticed the participant may be debarred to play further.
- 2) The school campus is under surveillance of CCTV cameras. Therefore, keep your participants informed about the same.
- 3) Last entry in the school campus is permitted up to 9:00 p. m. only.
- 4) **The participant schools leaving station before scheduled departure are required to inform GPS authorities at least 4 hours before their departure.**
- 5) On 30th December the participants who will be leaving the campus before lunch time, if need packed meals, the information to be given to the authorities before 9.00 am on that day.
- 6) Local participants need to inform the authorities in advance if they need food from school on payable basis.
